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The "Sant Maral" foundation presents the results of the survey, conducted from May 1 to May 19, 2020. The representative sample of 1200 respondents were collected in the capital Ulan Bator and Bayankhongor, Govi-Altay, Dundgovi, Uvurkhangay, Khovd, Sukhbaatar, Tuv aymags (split proportionally by 4 regional divisions and Ulan Bator).


